



# Execution Phase 2: Long-Term Integration




# Risk Mitigation: Challenges to Anticipate



## The Credential Crisis

Reality: Regulated jobs (Doctors, Engineers) face licensing delays of years.

**STRATEGY:** Plan for 'survival jobs' or bridge training programs.



## The Housing Squeeze

Reality: Vacancy rates are critically low (1-2%). Landlords demand credit checks.

**STRATEGY:** Look to Secondary Cities (e.g., London, ON or Moncton, NB) where rents are 20-30% lower.



# Common Questions for the 2026 Migrant



## Is Canada safe?

Yes. Consistently ranked globally safe. Emergency: 911.



## Do I need French?

Only in Quebec. However, the 2026 plan targets 9% Francophone admissions outside Quebec, offering an advantage in Express Entry.



## Which province is best?

There is no single best. It is a trade-off: Wages (Alberta), Access (Manitoba), or Jobs (Ontario).
