
The Conflict: While the goal is simple, the process has changed. Recent 2025 policy changes have transformed a once straightforward process into a complex landscape of program-specific restrictions.

The New Reality: 2025 Policy Alert

Spousal Open Work Permits (SOWP) are no longer guaranteed for all international students.



Pathway 1: The Spousal Open Work Permit (SOWP)

The Gold Standard for eligible applicants.



Benefits: Allows the spouse or common-law partner to work for almost any employer in Canada.

Who Qualifies?

- ✓ Must meet the Master's Degree Restriction criteria (Master's >16mo, PhD, or Professional Degree).
- ✓ Valid for the duration of the principal applicant's study permit.



Data Pill

Cost: ~\$255 CAD

Processing: 3-5 Months



Pathway 2: The Visitor Visa (TRV)

A strategic alternative for family unity.

Strategy Note

Pro-Tip: If ineligible for SOWP (e.g., College stream), this is the best option to ensure your spouse can reside with you, even without work rights.



The Constraint

Cannot work in Canada.



The Benefit

Can accompany the principal applicant and live in Canada.

Duration matches the principal applicant's permit.

Cost: ~\$100 CAD per person



Pathway 3: Minor Children

Ensuring education and status.



Arrival & Schooling

Right to attend public school (K-12). Often tuition-free.

Status Strategy

Study Permit highly recommended (\$150 CAD) to ensure independent legal status.

Turning 18/19

Must apply as an adult international student.



The Financial Foundation (LICO Standards)


Minimum liquid funds required for 2026.



Consultant's Whisper:

Strategy Note: Do not just show the minimum. A financial buffer significantly increases approval chances. Funds must be liquid.

Total Cumulative Proof Required.




Proving the Relationship

Documentation is the key to legitimacy.

1

Spouse



Marriage Certificate.

2

Common-Law



Statutory Declaration + 12 months cohabitation proof (leases/bills).

3

Children



Birth Certificates (both parents named).

The "Love Story" Strategy (For New Marriages)

To avoid 'Marriage of Convenience' refusals, include a **Letter of Explanation** with:

-  Photos of the wedding and outings.
-  Communication logs and chat history.
-  Detailed relationship timeline.

Strategic Timing: When to Apply?

Concurrent (Applying Together)

-  **Pros:** Family arrives together.
-  **Cons:** Higher immediate financial burden.
-  Riskier if funds are borderline.

Subsequent (Applying Later)

-  **Pros:** Safer if funds are tight.
-  Allows principal to establish housing first.
-  **Cons:** Results in a period of separation.

Takeaway: Choose based on your financial strength and risk tolerance.

Costs & Timelines At A Glance


| Pathway | Government Fee (CAD) | Processing Estimate |
|---------------------------------|----------------------|---------------------|
| Spousal Open Work Permit (SOWP) | \$255 | 3–5 Months |
| Visitor Visa (TRV) | \$100 | Varies by country |
| Child Study Permit | \$150 | 8–14 Weeks |
| Biometrics (Family Max) | \$170 | Once every 10 years |

Fees are estimates and subject to change by IRCC.
