


The 'Simple' Visa Is a Myth

Obtaining a Canadian Visitor Visa is currently one of the most challenging hurdles in immigration. A generic application is the fastest route to a refusal.


The 2026 Reality

- Refusal rates for Temporary Resident Visas (TRVs) are at an all-time high.
- Officers use AI tools like "Chinook" to process applications.
- Decisions are faster, but scrutiny is more intense.





Determining Your Path to Entry



Visa-Exempt

Examples: UK, France, Australia

Requirement:	Electronic Travel Authorization (eTA)
Cost:	\$7 CAD
Process:	Simple, primarily for air travel.


Visa-Required

Examples: India, China, Nigeria

Requirement:	Temporary Resident Visa (TRV)
Cost:	\$100 CAD
Process:	Complex, evidence-heavy.
Result:	Counterfoil placed in passport.



The Super Visa: A Long-Term Family Solution



Who is it for?

Parents & Grandparents of Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents.

The Insurance Requirement

Mandatory private Canadian medical insurance. Minimum \$100,000 coverage.


The Income Requirement

Host child must meet the Minimum Necessary Income (LICO) threshold.



The Core Objective: Proving You Are 'Bona Fide'

The burden of proof is on you.



The Risk: Section 179(b)


Refusal based on failure to prove you will leave Canada at the end of your stay.

Strategy Pillar 1: Proving Temporary Intent

- **The Trap:** Officers are trained to suspect you will not leave.
- **The Defense:** Demonstrate that your **ties to your home country** are **stronger** than your ties to Canada.

Required Evidence:

1. **Employment:** Letters confirming job tenure and that your position awaits your return.
2. **Assets:** Property deeds, business ownership, or vehicle registration.
3. **Family:** Evidence of spouse or children remaining in the home country.



Ties to Home




Strategy Pillar 2: Demonstrating Financial Stability



The Standard

You must afford the trip without working.

Rule of Thumb: ~\$1,000–\$1,500 CAD per month of stay.



Solid Proof

- Bank statements (4–6 months history)
- Host support (T4s, Paystubs)
- Consistent balance history



The Red Flag

- Large, unexplained lump-sum deposits
- Borrowed money just for the application
- Sudden spikes in balance

Strategy Pillar 3: Clarifying the Purpose of Visit

The officer needs to know: Why now?



Tourism

Requires a detailed itinerary. Include hotel bookings, travel dates, and planned activities. Vague plans are rejected.



Family Visit

Specific events carry more weight: Weddings, births, graduations. General 'reunions' need more context.



Business

Must be supported by a formal invitation letter from a Canadian company outlining the meeting or conference.

Execution Roadmap: Preparation & Evidence



The Portal

Create IRCC account. Answer questionnaire to generate document checklist.




Evidence Gathering

Focus on quality, not minimums.



Execution Roadmap: Submission & Biometrics




Obtain formal Letter of Invitation from host. Notarize for high-stakes cases.

Upload docs.
Pay \$100 Visa Fee + \$85 Biometrics Fee.

Wait for Instruction Letter (BIL).
Visit Visa Application Centre (VAC) promptly.

Anatomy of a Refusal: Common Red Flags



Section 179(b): Family Ties

The officer believes family ties in Canada are stronger than ties to home.



Unclear Purpose

Lack of itinerary, vague travel dates, or generic reasons.




Financial Instability

Unexplained funds, insufficient history, or large recent deposits.

Crucial Insight: A refusal remains on your permanent record. Avoid it at all costs.

Advanced Strategy: Understanding 'Dual Intent'



Can you visit while waiting for Permanent Residence?

YES. This is Dual Intent.

The Requirement:

You must prove that IF your PR application is refused, you will still leave Canada when your visitor status expires.

2026 Snapshot: Costs & Timelines

 FEES (CAD)	 PROCESSING	 DURATION
Visitor Visa: \$100	Time: 14 – 60 Days	Standard TRV: Up to 6 months
Family Max: \$500	Note: Highly variable by country of residence.	Super Visa: Up to 5 years
Biometrics: \$85 (Valid 10 years)		

Frequently Asked Questions

Can I work?

No. You may interview, but cannot start work without a valid Work Permit.

Do I need insurance?

Recommended for TRV. Mandatory (\$100k coverage) for Super Visa.

Can I extend my stay?

Yes. Apply for a 'Visitor Record' at least 30 days before current status expires.

Why refuse if I have money?

Money isn't enough. Without ties to home (job/property), you will be refused regardless of wealth.
