Provinces hand-pick specific skills for local economies.



How the Nomination Guarantees Your Invitation



Enhanced Streams

Link directly to Express Entry for faster electronic processing.

Base Streams

Paper-based applications for those outside the Express Entry system (slower processing).

Which Eligibility 'Bucket' Do You Fit Into?

Simplifying 80+ streams into three primary pathways.



1. The Job Offer Streams

Requires a valid, full-time offer. Employers typically do not need an LMIA but must meet revenue/compliance rules.



2. The Human Capital Streams

No job offer required. Provinces search the Express Entry pool for specific talent (e.g., Healthcare, Tech, Trades).



3. The International Grad Streams

Exclusive to students who graduated from a Designated Learning Institution (DLI) within that specific province.

Ontario (OINP) – The High-Volume Heavyweight

Stream Highlights

- **Human Capital Priorities:** Scours Express Entry for Bachelor's degree holders in high-demand sectors.
- **French-Speaking Skilled Worker:** For bilingual candidates (English + French).
- **Employer Job Offer:** Requires a permanent offer from an Ontario employer.

Fast Facts

Note: Largest quotas but highest competition.

Entrepreneur Stream: Net worth from \$200k (rural) + job creation.



The Western Powerhouses

Tech Hubs vs. Rural Renewal


British Columbia (BC PNP)

- **Focus:** Tech-forward points-based system.
- **BC Tech Stream:** Priority processing for 29 occupations. Weekly draws.
- **Requirement:** Job offer usually required.

Alberta (AAIP)

- **Focus:** Economic development and rural ties.
- **The Edge:** Invites candidates with CRS scores as low as **300**.
- **Rural Renewal:** Job offers in participating rural communities.

The Community Connectors – Saskatchewan & Manitoba



Saskatchewan (SINP)



No Canadian Job Offer Needed

Invites overseas candidates with high-skilled experience, post-secondary education, and CLB 4+.

Manitoba (MPNP)



Strong Connection Required

Points-based system favoring relatives, previous education, or past employment in the province.

Requires genuine long-term intent to stay.



The Investment – Fees & Timelines (2026 Estimates)

Province	Fee (CAD)	Processing Time	Key Note
Ontario (OINP)	\$1,500	3–4 Months	Largest Quota
British Columbia (BC PNP)	\$1,475	2–3 Months	Weekly Tech Draws
Alberta (AAIP)	\$840	3–5 Months	Agri/Tech Popularity
Saskatchewan (SINP)	\$350	4–15 Weeks	Best Value
Nova Scotia (NSNP)	\$0	3 Months+	Highly Competitive

Fees paid to Province, separate from Federal fees.

The “Kill Switch” – Intent to Reside



Toronto
(Current Residence)

REFUSED



Manitoba
(Application Target)

This is the #1 reason for refusal. PNPs are tied to local economic contribution.

The Proof:

The Proof: You must demonstrate ties—leases, employment, or family—to the nominating province, not just a desire for PR.

Navigating Pitfalls & Common Questions



Q: Can I apply to multiple provinces?

A: Risky. It signals a lack of “**Intent to Reside.**” Focus on your strongest match.



Q: Do I need an LMIA for a job offer?

A: Usually, no. Most PNP streams are **LMIA-exempt**, saving \$1,000 and months of time.



Q: Can I move after getting PR?


A: Moving immediately can trigger “**Misrepresentation**” investigations. Safer to stay 1–2 years.



Q: What is the “easiest” program?

A: None. Only the “**best fit.**” Saskatchewan and Alberta have lower thresholds for specific jobs.
