Understanding Grandfathered Status

For holders of a Letter of Support/Certificate dated pre-2026.

You have secured the "Golden Ticket" before the cutoff. You are technically safe from the pause, but you are not safe from the clock.

The Grace Period: IRCC has granted a specific window to finalize applications. Failure to act within this window forfeits your grandfathered status.

New Applicants & The Entrepreneur Pilot STATUS: INTAKE PAUSED

Why the Pause?

The program became a victim of its own success. The pause allows IRCC to clear the 3-year backlog.

The Upcoming Pilot

- **Launch:** Expected mid-to-late 2026.
- **Goal:** Faster, more efficient, stricter vetting.
- **Changes:** Capped intake, higher funding requirements, strict Active Management enforcement.

Work Permit Restrictions

New "Optional Work Permits" for SUV are currently restricted for this group.



The Strategic Pivot: C11 Significant Benefit Work Permit

The best alternative for those caught in the pause.



The Solution: Apply for the C11 Work Permit.

- **Mechanism:** Entrepreneur work permit based on bringing “significant economic benefit” to Canada.
- **Advantage:** Gets you to Canada NOW to start operations.
- **Strategy:** Build a “shovel-ready” business with revenue/validation. Once the new Pilot launches in late 2026, you will be in a prime position to apply.



Strategic Comparison: Legacy vs. Future vs. C11

	Legacy SUV (Pre-2026)	Future Entrepreneur Pilot	C11 Work Permit
Status	Open (Deadline June 30)	Coming Soon (Late 2026)	Open Now
Processing	37+ Months	Expected to be faster	Standard Work Permit times
Benefit	Direct PR application	Clean slate, less backlog	Immediate entry; bridge to future PR



The Foundation: Core Eligibility Requirements

These criteria apply to the legacy program and are expected to form the baseline for the new Pilot.

The Letter of Support

- Venture Capital: Min. \$200k investment
- Angel Groups: Min. \$75k investment
- Incubators: Acceptance into program (No investment req, but highest scrutiny)

Ownership Structure

- Each applicant: Min. 10% voting rights
- Total (Applicants + Org): >50% voting rights

Language

- CLB 5 (English/French) - Generally considered a low barrier.



Financial Requirements & Government Fees

Settlement Funds vs. Investment

You must prove financial independence distinct from business capital.

~\$15,143 CAD

For a single applicant (updated annually).

For C11 or the new Pilot, showing additional personal capital strongly increases credibility.

Estimated 2026 Government Fees

- Principal Applicant PR: \$2,385 (includes RPRF)
- Spouse: \$1,525
- Dependent Child: \$260
- Biometrics: \$85 (once/10 years)




Critical Risk #1: The 'Active Management' Trap

This is not a passive investment visa. Presence is mandatory.

REFUSAL RISK



Home Country



Canada

Staying in your home country while "co-founders" run the business in Canada.

REQUIREMENT



Canada

You must actively manage the business from inside Canada once you arrive.




Critical Risk #2: Shell Companies & Peer Reviews



Target:	Primarily the Business Incubator stream.
The Issue:	Paying fees to an incubator but performing no genuine business activity (Shell Company).
The Mechanism:	PEER REVIEW.
The Outcome:	IRCC requests independent audits. If the audit finds a lack of genuine activity, the application is refused. The new Pilot will have stricter enforcement.

Critical Risk #3: Group Linkage & The Domino Effect



THE CONCEPT: Up to 5 founders can apply together, but they are legally linked.

THE RISK: If the Essential Person is refused (medical, criminal, or eligibility), ALL other members are automatically refused.

TAKEAWAY: Choose your co-founders wisely.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Is the SUV Cancelled?

A: No. It is paused for a reset/backlog clearance. Existing apps are processing.

Q: Can I bring my family?

A: Yes. Spouses and dependent children (under 22) receive PR.

Q: When will the new Pilot open?

A: Experts expect late 2026.

Q: Can I get a work permit now?

A: Only if you have a 2025 Certificate (SUV Work Permit) or if you pivot to the C11 (Entrepreneur Work Permit).
